SUBJECT: An Ordinance Adding Section 61.301 (i) to Chapter 61 of
the Sacramento City Code Relating to the Definition of
an Inoperative Vehicle.

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the Law and Legislation Committee approve the subject ordinance which will add a section to Chapter 61 of the Sacramento City Code (Nuisance Code) relating to the definition of an inoperative vehicle.

BACKGROUND

There is currently no definition of an inoperative vehicle in the Nuisance Code. The proposed addition to the code would provide a definition as to what constitutes an "inoperative vehicle", thereby establishing guidelines for enforcement personnel as well as citizens as to what conditions would cause a vehicle to be declared inoperative. In addition to mechanical conditions a vehicle could be declared inoperative by reason that it cannot be operated on a public street or highway because it is not registered.



**AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 61.301 (i) TO CHAPTER 61
OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE RELATING TO THE
DEFINITION OF AN INOPERATIVE VEHICLE**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1.

Subsection (i) of Section 61.301 is hereby added to Chapter 61 of the Sacramento City Code to read as follows:

- (i) **Inoperative Vehicle:** Any motor vehicle which cannot be moved under its own power, or cannot be operated lawfully on a public street or highway within this state, due to removal of, damage to, or deterioration of, or inoperative condition of any component part or the lack of an engine, transmission, wheels, tires, doors, windshield or any other component part necessary for such movement or lawful operation or which cannot be operated on a public street or highway because it is not currently registered and fees paid to the California Department of Motor Vehicles.
