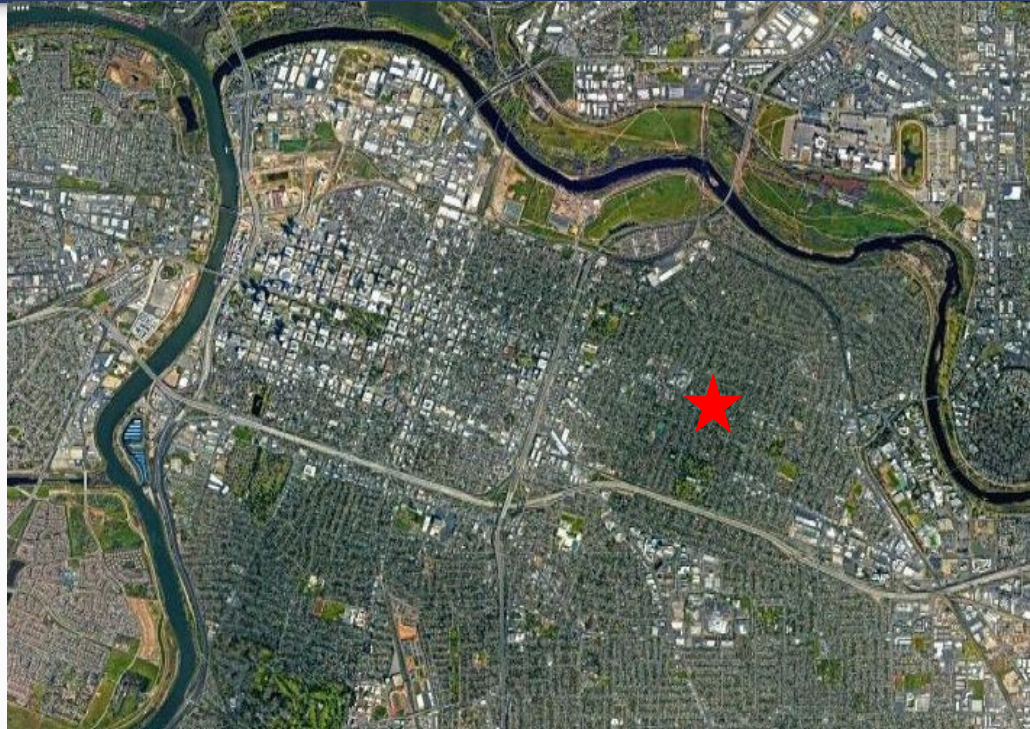

- Historic Environment Consultants produced evaluation

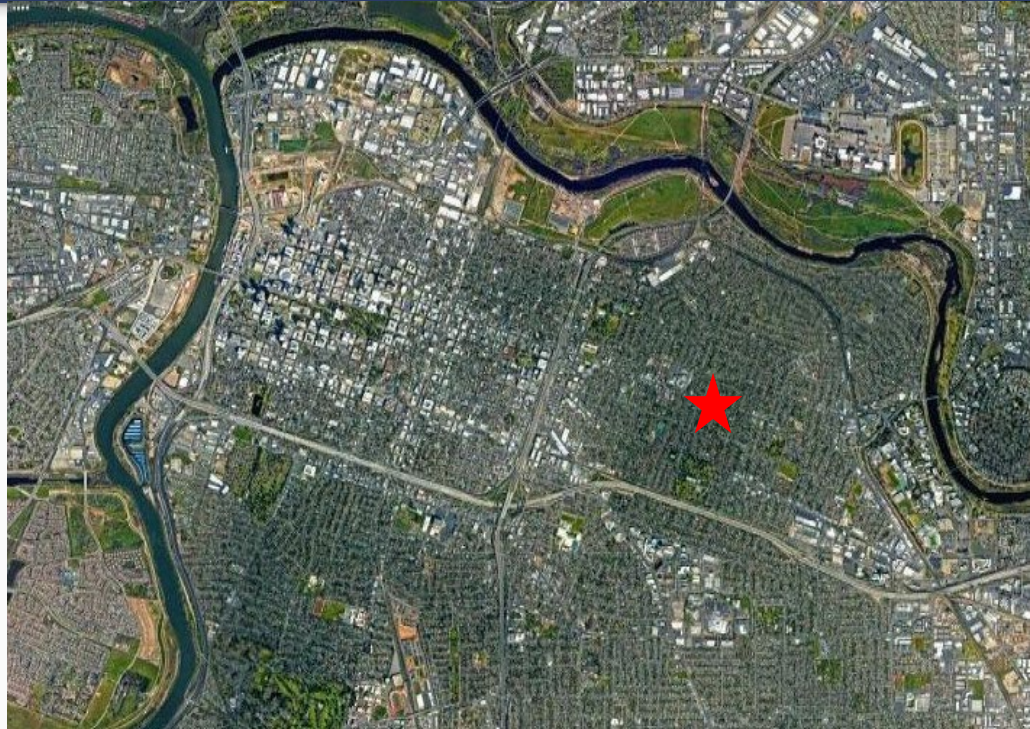
