

ORDINANCE NO. 947, FOURTH SERIES


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE, IN ADDITION TO THE TWO ALREADY ORDERED, 7½ H. P. FEDERAL ELECTRICAL SIRENS WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in open market, without first advertising for bids, two (2) 7½ H. P. Federal Electrical Sirens, at a cost of \$760.00 (plus sales tax), in addition to the two already ordered, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that it is thought that the two sirens already ordered may not be adequate to warn all parts of the city in event of black-out for air raid and it is necessary that they be obtained immediately.
