SUBJECT: Appeal of Robert Clayton from the Decision of the Animal Control Division regarding Vicious Animals

SUMMARY

Attached is the appeal of Robert Clayton from the decision of the Animal Control Division regarding vicious animals, as required by Section 6.101 of the Sacramento City Code.

BACKGROUND

Under Sections 2.323 and 2.324 of the City Code, the Council may appoint a hearing examiner to hear the appeal if it finds that "the appeal may involve a lengthy factfinding process which would be more appropriately accomodated by a formal hearing before a hearing examiner."

FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost would be \$100.00 and would be available from the Animal Control Division budget.

RECOMMENDATIONS



If the Council should decide to appoint a hearing examiner, it is recommended that the following motion be adopted: "The Council hereby determines pursuant to Section 2.324, City Code, that this appeal will involve a lengthy factfinding process which will be more appropriately accomodated by a formal hearing before


