SUBJECT: RECOMMENDATION FOR TWO HOUR PARKING REGULATIONS ON FOLSOM BOULEVARD FROM SEVILLE STREET TO 34TH STREET AND ON SEGMENTS OF 32ND AND 33RD STREETS

SUMMARY

This report recommends the addition of two (2) hour parking regulations on the north side of Folsom Boulevard from Seville Street to 34th Street, on both sides of 32nd Street from Folsom Boulevard North 40 feet, and on the West side of 33rd Street from Folsom Boulevard North 54 feet.

BACKGROUND

Due to the impact of all-day parkers on Folsom Boulevard, the business owners of the area submitted a petition for two-hour parking regulations Monday through Saturday from 8 A.M. until 6 P.M. The petition represents 71% of the businesses in the area. Two-hour parking regulations would provide short-term customer parking while eliminating all-day commuter parking.

FINANCIAL

The cost to implement these recommended parking regulations is \$600 for regulatory signing. Funds are available in the Traffic Signs and Markings operational budget (101-310-3122-4471).

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This recommendation is consistent with Sacramento City Code 25.109 which provides for regulation of parking on any street designated by resolution of the City Council.

## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PARKING TIME LIMITS ON THE NORTH SIDE OF FOLSOM BOULEVARD FROM SEVILLE STREET TO 34TH STREET AND ON SEGMENTS OF 32ND AND 33RD STREET

Whereas, pursuant to Section 25.109 of the Sacramento City Code when authorized signs have been placed giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets for a period of time longer than specified on the signs;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The following streets shall be regulated by two hour time limits from 8 A.M. To 6 P.M., Monday through Saturday:

- Folsom Boulevard, North side, from Seville Street to 34th Street
- 32nd Street, both sides, 40 feet from Folsom Boulevard
- 33rd Street, West side 54 feet North of Folsom Blvd.
