SUBJECT: Printing for Sacramento History Center Public Opening

SUMMARY

This is a request for City Council to suspend competitive bidding and authorize the City Manager to approve printing of a poster, brochure, tickets, etc. for the opening of the Sacramento History Center.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sacramento History Center is a joint venture between the City, County, and Sacramento History Center, Inc. The building is now complete, and exhibits are being installed by Sacramento History Center, Inc. The Center is scheduled for public opening in July 1985.

The City approved an operations agreement with Sacramento History Center, Inc., for the operations of the Center and provided \$165,210 in the Museum and History Division's FY 1984-85 budget to hire necessary staff and supplies for the startup of operations. Included in those startup funds was \$21,379 for printing of posters, brochures, tickets, etc. Graphic designers are just completing the design work for these items, and it is necessary to have them printed in time for the opening. Normal procedures would not allow enough time to produce these items for the public opening.

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FINANCIAL IMPACT

All funds necessary for this project are approved and in the FY 1984-85 budget. No new funds are requested.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, waive the competitive bidding process for printing costs in conjunction with the opening of the Sacramento History Center and authorize the City Manager to sign contract(s) not to exceed \$21,379 for this work. Graphics designers shall provide three informal bids for printing each item.
