SUBJECT: RECOMMENDATION TO REGULATE PARKING TIME LIMITS ON 15TH
STREET BETWEEN X STREET AND BROADWAY

SUMMARY:

This report recommends the addition of a one-hour parking time limit on the east side of 15th Street between X Street and Broadway.

BACKGROUND:

Due to the heavy impact of all-day parkers on the east side of 15th Street between X Street and Broadway, the merchants submitted a petition for one-hour time limit parking. The petition submitted by the merchants represents 100% of the addresses in the block. A survey and study of on-street parking conditions in the area was conducted. Based on these results, it was determined that the area is eligible for a one-hour parking limit.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The cost to implement this small area is \$130.00. Funds are available in the Traffic Signs and Markings operational budget - Construction and Building Supplies (101-310-3122-4471).







ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

A RESOLUTION REGULATING PARKING TIME
LIMITS ON 15TH STREET BETWEEN X
STREET AND BROADWAY

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Sacramento:

Pursuant to Section 25.109 of the Sacramento City Code, when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets for a period of time longer than indicated on the signs.

One-hour zone between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

East side of 15th Street between X Street and Broadway.
