SUMMARY

This report is submitted for approval of Change Order No. 1 to this contract.

BACKGROUND

The landfill requires additional cover material for normal operations.

The Morrison Creek Assessment District Project has surplus embankment material available for disposal. This Change Order provides 50,000 cubic yards be delivered on the landfill site at \$2.80 per cubic yard. The Change Order also covers the cost of a motorgrader and operator to stockpile the delivered cover material in a proper fashion at the landfill site.

FINANCIAL


The original contract for Morrison Creek Assessment District was in the amount of \$4,741,106.02. Change Order No. 1 is in the amount of \$160,600 making a total construction cost of \$4,901,706.02. Since the dirt will be used for the Landfill Project, the cost of the Change Order will be covered by monies from that project, which has more than sufficient funds to cover the cost of the Change Order.


