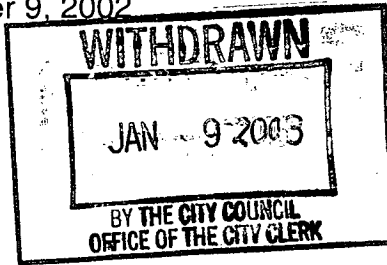

SUBJECT: RESOLUTION TO PROHIBIT ALL PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON A PORTION OF RALEY BOULEVARD

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Raley Boulevard, east side, from Vinci Avenue south for seven hundred feet. Council District 2.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution prohibiting all parking during certain hours on a portion of Raley Boulevard.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends prohibiting all parking from 10 pm to 7am on the east side of Raley Boulevard from Vinci Avenue south for seven hundred feet (Exhibit A). Large trucks often park along this section of the street for several days at a time. Prohibiting parking at night will solve this problem and still allow customers to park during the day.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Composite Engineering Inc. is the sole tenant of three contiguous buildings located at 5391, 5381, and 5301 Raley Boulevard.
- They have been experiencing problems with large trucks parking along this section of Raley Boulevard. Some trucks are left parked on the street for days.
- Prohibiting all parking from 10 pm to 7 am will deter trucks from this location and will still provide customer street parking during the day.
- This is the only business that will be impacted by the parking restriction.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking restriction is estimated to be \$500 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This recommendation is consistent with the City's strategic plan and the goal of the City Council to promote and support economic vitality.



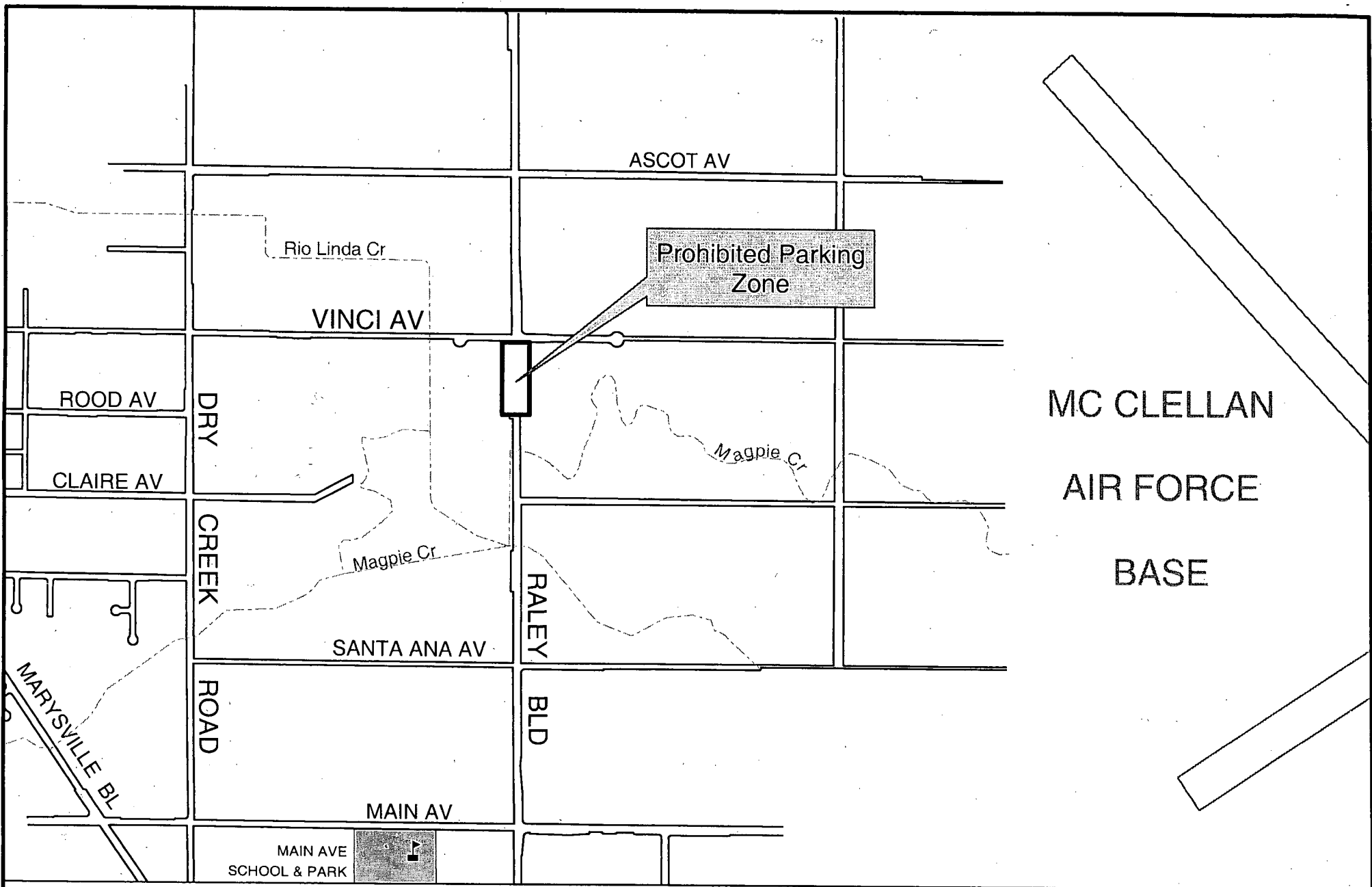

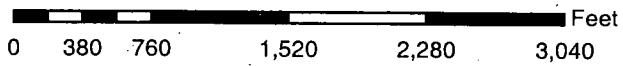

**RESOLUTION PROHIBITING ALL PARKING
DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON A PORTION OF RALEY BOULEVARD**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.36.040 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs are in place giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park on the days indicated on such signs, between the hours specified on such signs or upon any of the streets described in resolutions duly adopted by the City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

All parking shall be prohibited from 10 pm to 7 am on the following street:

- Raley Boulevard, east side, from Vinci Avenue south for seven hundred feet.
