

RESOLUTION NO. 85-845

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING EDGAR A. SAYRE, JR.

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Edgar Sayre on the twenty-third day of October 1985, at the age of seventy-six, in Sacramento, California; and,

WHEREAS, Edgar Sayre was a well-known and respected member of the Sacramento community whose exemplary efforts and accomplishments were of great benefit to the citizens and the City of Sacramento; and,

WHEREAS, Edgar Sayre served the people of this community with dedication and distinction as Foreman of the County Grand Jury in 1948 and 1949, as a member of the Sacramento City Council from 1950 to 1960, and as Sacramento County's Auditor-Controller from 1967 to 1983; and,

WHEREAS, while serving as a City Council Member, Edgar Sayre helped organize the Sacramento Historic Landmarks Commission, and a youth employment organization that found part-time work for students; and,

WHEREAS, Edgar Sayre's outstanding public service career also included affiliations with historical groups, chambers of commerce, service clubs, and veterans groups; and,

WHEREAS, Edgar Sayre was an exceptional person who touched the lives of many and who will be deeply missed by all who came to know him; and,

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Edgar Sayre, and so, has caused this Resolution to be prepared;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Edgar Sayre.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to his bereaved family, as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
