SUBJECT: New Ramona Colony Assessment District (JN:1217) - Approval of  
Cooperative Agreement with Sacramento County Sanitation  
District No. 1

SUMMARY

The attached agreement between the City of Sacramento and County Sanitation District No. 1 of the County of Sacramento provides for a contribution for the construction of trunk sewer facilities to the proposed New Ramona Colony Assessment District. Execution of the agreement is recommended.

BACKGROUND

The New Ramona Colony Assessment District area, which is currently under design, is bounded by Light Rail tracks on the north, 14th Avenue on the south, Southern Pacific on the west, and Power Inn Road on the east. The proposed District will finance construction of overall infrastructure improvements, including construction of sanitary sewer facilities. The attached agreement provides for County Sanitation District funding of the sanitary sewer trunk lines that will be constructed as part of the assessment district.

FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated construction cost for the trunk-related facilities is \$321,975. The "not-to-exceed" limit contained in the reimbursement agreement is \$385,261, which includes the estimated construction cost, \$31,088 for construction staking, inspection, engineering, and contract administration, and a 10 percent contingency to provide for bidding uncertainties and possible field encountered changes. budget will be established and will include provisions of the subject agreement after the assessment district is formed.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This agreement is consistent with existing City policy concerning payment for sanitary trunk sewers within the boundaries of County Sanitation District No. 1.

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution which authorizes execution of the attached agreement.

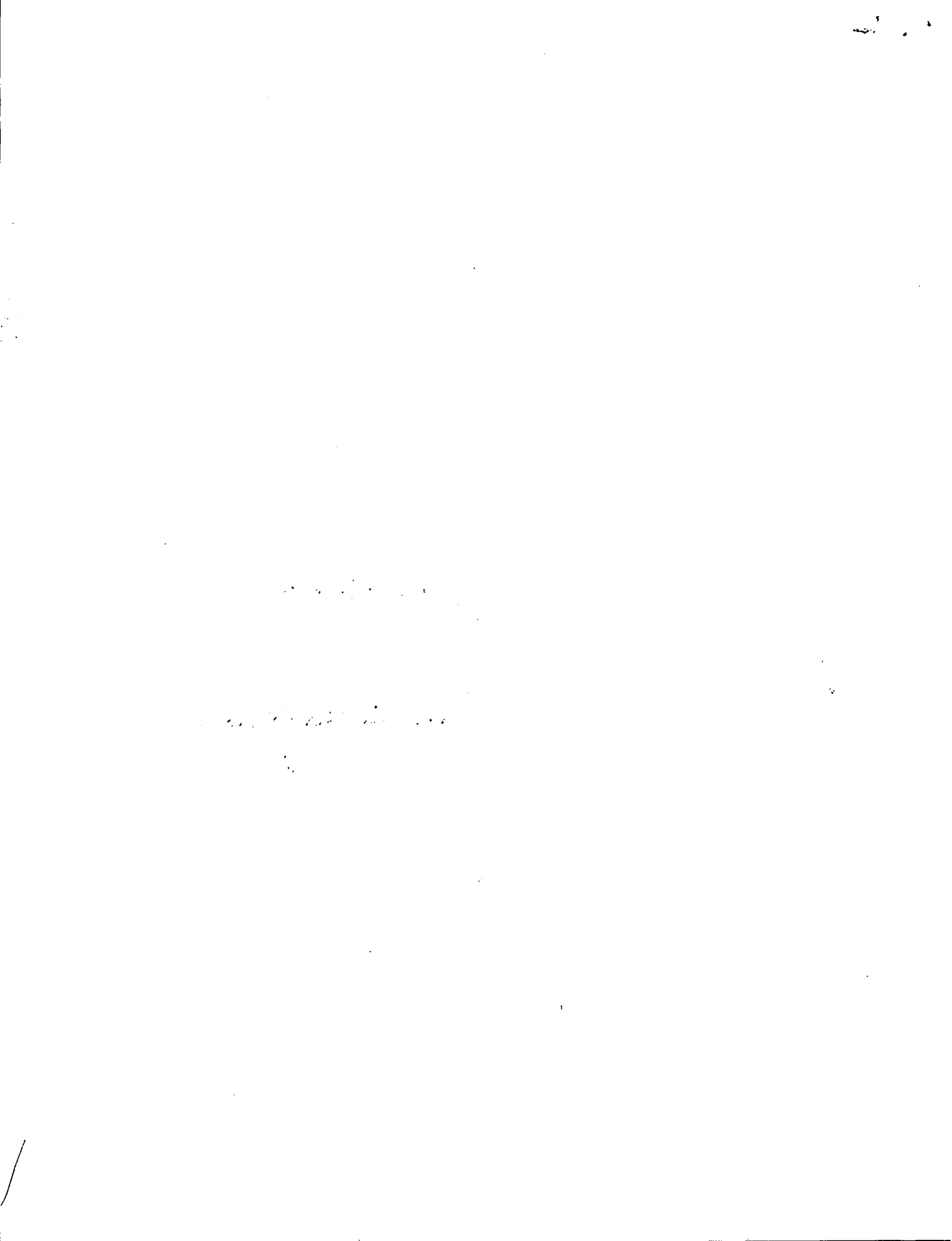

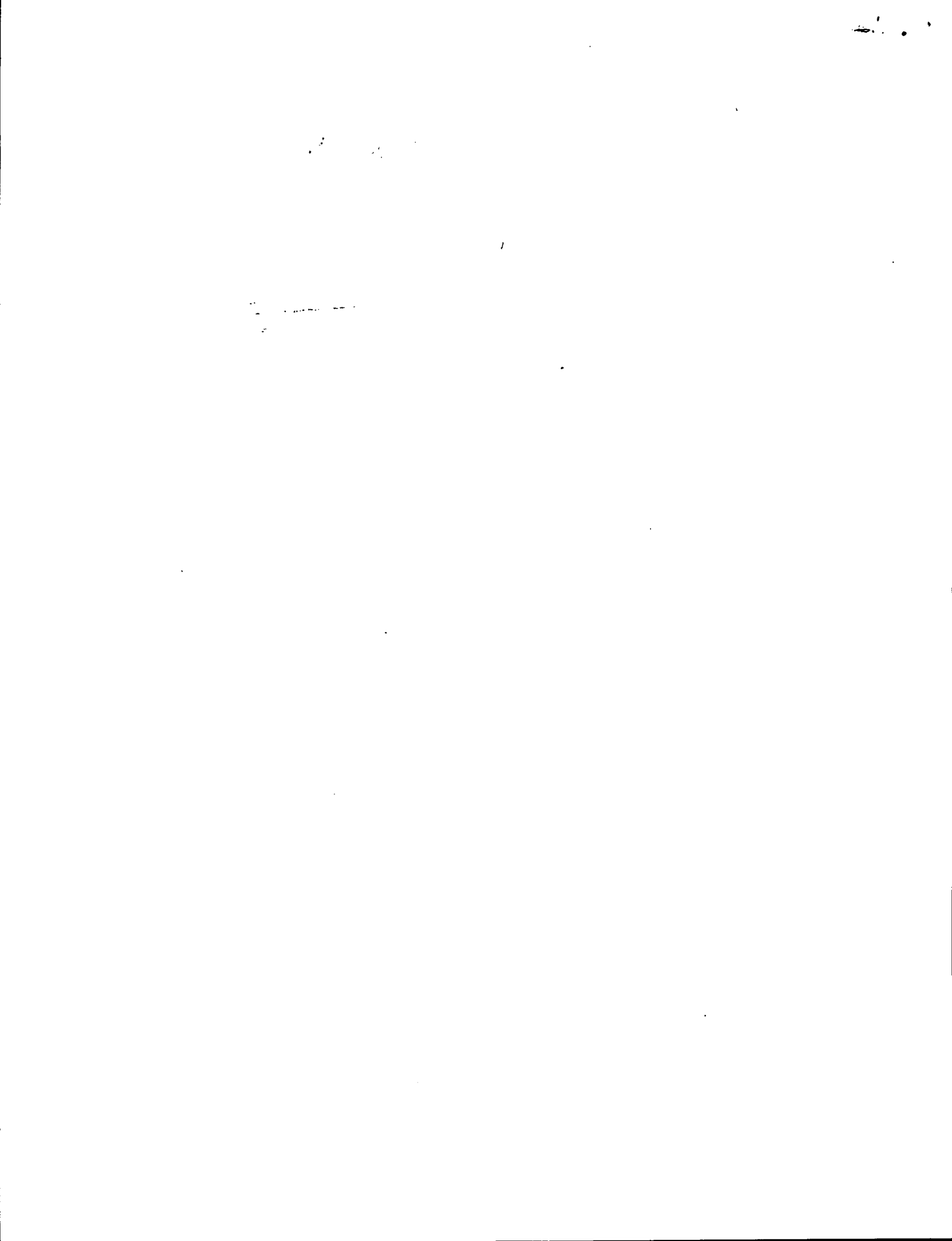
