ORDINANCE NO. 2574

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.73-2 AND 2.73-3, ARTICLE IV, CHAPTER 2, SACRAMENTO CITY CODE, EXTENDING THE TIME TO JUNE 30, 1965, FOR THE PRESERVATION OF BUILDINGS OF HISTORIC VALUE IN THE OLD SACRAMENTO AREA; MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2562, FOURTH SERIES

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Sections 2.73-2 and 2.73-3 of Article IV, Chapter 2, of the Sacramento City Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2.73-2. No building permit shall be issued by the Building Inspector from the date of the enactment of this amendment until June 30, 1965, for the reconstruction, alteration or demolition of any existing building or structure within the boundaries of the OLD SACRAMENTO area without the approval of the City Planning Commission after consultation with the Sacramento Historic Landmarks Commission for the purpose of determining whether or not any exterior architectural feature of historical significance is affected. Any person adversely affected may apply to the City Council for a hearing.

Sec. 2.73-3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to take effect immediately, such emergency being the necessity of extending the time for preservation of buildings of historic value in the OLD SACRAMENTO area until a precise plan now being formulated for the restoration of said area as an area of historical cultural value can be completed and submitted to the City Council.

SECTION 2.

Ordinance No. 2562, Fourth Series, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance shall be published once in the official newspaper of the City of Sacramento within ten days after passage.
