

# ORDINANCE NO. 90-040

## ORDINANCE ADDING DIVISION 4 (SECTION 60.17) TO ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 60 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE, RELATING TO APPOINTMENTS TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

### Section 1.

Division 4 (Section 60.17) is hereby added to Article I of Chapter 60 of the Sacramento City Code to read as follows:

#### Division 4. Limitation on Number of Consecutive Terms Served -- Boards and Commissions

#### Section 60.17. Limitation on Number of Consecutive Terms Served

- (a) No person appointed to any board or commission by the Mayor with the concurrence of the City Council or by the City Council shall be appointed to serve more than two (2) consecutive terms.
- (b) Subsection (a) shall not apply:
  - (i) If the appointee is the Mayor or a member of the City Council.
  - (ii) If the appointee is appointed jointly by the Mayor or City Council and any other appointing authority.

- (c) A member appointed to complete an unexpired term shall be eligible to serve up to two consecutive terms in addition to the unexpired term.
- (d) If an ordinance creating a board or commission specifies a more restrictive limitation on length of service than is set forth in this section, the more restrictive provision shall apply. If an ordinance creating a board or commission is less restrictive, the two-term limitation of this section shall apply.
- (e) A person shall be eligible for reappointment to a board or commission two years after the last date the member served on the board or commission.
