The Civil Service Board met in special session this date at 1.30 o'clock, p.m., with Commissioners Mason, Truesdale and Chairman Nathan in attendance.

City Manager H. C. Bottorff and City Controller Corning deSaules also in attendance at request of the Board.

The minutes of the meeting held June 26, June 27 and July 22, 1924, were read and approved as read.

Communication from Sheridan Strunk requesting further examination by the Board's physicians relative to his being appointed as a member of the Fire Department read and ordered filed; Mr. Strunk's request was denied by the Board; it being the opinion of the Board that no action could be taken as Mr. Strunk was rejected by Dr. Cress as not being physically fit to become a member of the Fire Department when he was certified to City Manager for appointment.

On motion by Commissioner Mason and seconded by Commissioner Truesdale and passed unaminously by the Board the following resolution was adopted; RESOLVED; That for the purpose of creating an eligible list in the position of Uniform Fireman the Civil Service Board will hold an entrance examination, applications will close November 10, 1924 at 5 o'clock, p.m., at which time all applications properly signed and sworn to must be in the hands of the Secretary of the Board; medical examination to be held between the hours of 8 to 9 a.m., and 1 to 3 p.m., November 10th to 15th inclusive; Fireman's run to be held at State Fair grounds Sunday November 16th at 9 a.m., athletic test to start November 17th at 7 p.m., at the Y. M. C. A. gymnasium; educational test to be held Thursday evening December 4, 1924; the Secretary is hereby instructed to make all necessary arrangements to hold and conduct said

examination; and that the subject and weights shall be as follows;

Physical	(Tests of agility and strength)	5
	(Inspection)	2
Educational	(Spelling)	1
	(Arithmetic)	1
	(Special Subject; Rules & Duties)	3

and that any applicant failing to make 70 per cent or better in the strength and agility test or who shall average less than 70 per cent in the Special Subject (Rules & Duties) shall be deemed as having failed.
