SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing Execution of Agreement for Sewage Pumping Station 55 Discharge Line Design

SUMMARY:

Submitted is a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with Brown and Caldwell for consulting services for the subject design project. Adoption of the resolution is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

In 1983, the engineering firm of Brown and Caldwell performed a study for the City to determine reasonable alternatives for increasing capacity in Sewage Pumping Station No. 55. Preliminary routing of a new discharge line was studied, and a preliminary layout of additional pumping units was developed. Cost comparisons of possible routes were made. City staff have reviewed the findings of this study, and have approved the recommended route and the pumping modifications.

At the April 3, 1984 meeting, the City Council authorized the expenditure of \$40,000 for the design of the recommended project. Time is a major element in this project, as high groundwater normally limits the construction season in the Sump 55 area. We believe it would be economical in time and money to waive the consultant selection procedure and engage the firm of Brown and Caldwell to perform the final design. Our reasons are as follows:

1. The firm has demonstrated capability in design of wastewater pumping and conveyance facilities. Local office has designed significant portion of Regional County System.
2. Past projects with City and County have given Brown & Caldwell familiarity with local conditions and preferences in methods and materials of construction.
3. They have worked successfully with City staff on other projects.
4. As part of preliminary study on alternatives and costs, they have performed essentially a pre-design of the subject project. This will save time and money in the final design.

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
FINANCIAL:

It is estimated that the cost of the design project will be \$40,000. Sufficient funds have been appropriated to cover this amount.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Manager be authorized to execute an agreement with Brown and Caldwell for the design of the Sewage Pumping Station 55 discharge line by passage of the attached resolution.
