

ORDINANCE NO 414, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO PURCHASE 140 CUBIC YARDS CRUSHED GRAVEL AND OTHER SUPPLIES FOR PUBLIC TENNIS COURT WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The proper purchasing authorities of the City of Sacramento are hereby authorized and directed to purchase for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento: 140 Cu. Yds. Crushed Gravel, 920 Sacks Cement, 70+ Cubic Yards Marysville Sand, 16 lbs. Dry Lamp Black, 8 Cubic Yards Top-Sand, 300 Feet Elastite Expansion Joint, without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency existing because there is not sufficient time to advertise for bids and award a contract for the furnishing of such supplies and completion of said work in time for summer play on Tennis Court proposed to be built with said material, and it further appearing that no saving can be accomplished in the purchasing of said supplies even though the bids were asked for.
