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BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On November 12th, 1976, Payless Cashways, Inc., granted a drainage easement through their property on Indian Lane. Their new development plans for the property make it necessary to relocate this easement. A new easement has been granted to the City to replace the one to be abandoned. All work to be done in the new easement will be paid for by Payless Cashways, Inc.

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 5197

VACATING PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY AND EASEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 50430 TO 50442, INCLUSIVE, OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, a certain public right of way and easement, hereinafter specifically described, is not now necessary for the purpose for which said easement was dedicated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento is of the opinion that public interest and convenience require the vacation of said easement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby declares its intention to abandon the following described right of way and easement:

All that portion of the Southeast one-quarter of Section 31, Township 8 North, Range 5 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, City of Sacramento, recorded November 12th, 1976, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Northerly line of Area "B" as shown on that plat of Suvey filed in the Sacramento County Recorder's office in Book 6 of Surveys, Map No. 18, from which point the Northwest corner thereof bears South 88° 21' 00" West 31.02 feet, said Northwest corner of Area "B" also being the Northwest corner of Parcel "A" as shown on that Parcel Map filed in said Recorder's office in Book 25 of Parcel Maps, at Page 44; thence, from said POINT OF BEGINNING North 00° 07' 00" East 340.00 feet; thence, North 88° 21' 00" East 304.44 feet; thence, along the arc of a 15.00 radius curve which is concave to the Northwest, said arc being subtended by a chord which bears North 44° 14' 00" East 20.88 feet; thence North 00° 07' 00" East 381.63 feet; thence, North 76° 36' 06" East 129.92 feet, thence, along the arc of a 15.00 foot radius curve which is concave to the Northwest, said arc being subtended by a chord which bears North 39° 15' 14" East 18.20 feet; thence, North 01° 54' 23" East 75.15 feet to a point on the westerly right-of-way line of the Western Pacific Railroad; thence, along said line South 13° 23' 54" East 96.52 feet; thence leaving said line South 76° 36' 06" West 142.16 feet; thence along the arc of a 15.00 foot radius curve which is concave to the South east, said arc being subtended by a chord which bears South 38° 21' 33" West 18.57 feet; thence, South 00° 07' 00" West 359.56' feet; thence, along the arc of a 28.00 foot radius curve which is concave to the Northwest, said arc being subtended by a chord which bears South 44° 14' 00" West 38.99; thence, South 88° 21' 00" West 275.29 feet; thence, along the arc of a 15.00 foot radius curve which is concave to the Southeast, said arce being subtended by a chord which bears South 44° 14' 00" West 20.88; thence South 00° 07' 00" West 312.45 feet to a point on the Northerly line of said Parcel "A"; thence, along said Northerly line South 88° 2;' 00" West 15.00 feet to the point of beginning.

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OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK Together with the perpetual right and privilege of flowing water in, through, and along said canal, ditch or pipeline in such amounts and at such time as party of the second part shall deem necessity, and the perpetual right of ingress to and egress from said property, for the purpose of exercising and performing all of the rights and privileges herein granted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the 7th day of July, 1981, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. in the Council Chambers of the City of Sacramento, in the City Hall on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets in said City, be, and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the hearing of the proposed vacation of said right of way and easement above described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be directed to publish Notice of Hearing of the proposed vacation of said public right of way and easement in the Daily Recorder, as required by law, and that said Notice be posted along said right of way and easement to be vacated in accordance with the provisions of Sections 50440 and 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California.
