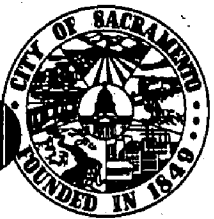



Following are examples of ballot language which could be used in connection with the two alternatives for the Memorial Auditorium renovation.

**Auditorium/Theater**

Shall general obligation bonds in the principal amount of \$15,000,000 be authorized to rehabilitate, reconstruct and renovate the Memorial Auditorium for use as a fixed seat theater, with redesigned floor and balconies, and for other theatrical, assembly and convention related purposes?

**Auditorium/Multi-Purpose**

Shall general obligation bonds in the principal amount of \$15,000,000 be authorized to rehabilitate, reconstruct and renovate the Memorial Auditorium for use as a multi-purpose facility with no fixed seats on the arena floor and with general retention of the existing auditorium configuration, and for other theatrical, assembly and convention related purposes?
