

ORDINANCE NO. 1217 FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THAT CERTAIN PUBLIC WORK BE DONE BY THE CITY WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

WHEREAS, the City Manager of the City of Sacramento has recommended that the following described work be done by the City without first advertising for bids,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The City Council hereby directs and authorizes that the following described work shall be done by the City, without first advertising for bids.

SECTION 2: The work to be done is the installation by the City, according to the standard practice of the City of Sacramento, of TWO (2) STANDARD 4" FIRE HYDRANTS, TOGETHER WITH APPROXIMATELY 600 FEET OF 6" ASBESTOS-CEMENT OR CAST IRON PIPE and SIX (6) INCH GATE VALVES on the property of the Sacramento Municipal Utility District located in the City of Sacramento between 55th and 59th Streets and the Southern Pacific Railway property and Folsom Boulevard.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure to take effect immediately; such emergency being that it is necessary that fire protection be provided for the property involved herein.


