SUBJECT: Approval of Preliminary Plans for 5th and I

Associates Office Building, 5th-6th-I-J Block

SUMMARY

The attached resolution approves the Preliminary Plans as submitted by 5th and I Associates for the 190,000 sq.ft. office building and parking facility to be constructed on the 5th-6th-I-J Block in Project #4.

BACKGROUND

The Housing and Redevelopment Commission approved the Preliminary Plans for this project on April 21, 1980. Architectural Review Board considered the plans on May 21, P.O. BOX 1834 1980 and made a final review and approval on June 4, 1980 subject to a detailed landscaping plan and an irrigational SACRAMENTO, CA 95814 plan being submitted at the final plan stage. The Planning (916) 444-9210 Commission approved a special permit for the required parking on May 22, 1980.

> The major revisions to the plans from the original concept consist of a "flip" of the major office tower moving the west end of the structure to the east end. This now provides the major entry plaza at 5th and J Streets instead of 6th and J Streets. All parties have considered this to be an improvement to the plan since it opens up the entry vista to the on-coming traffic which flows eastward on J Street. An additional change to the I Street facade uncovers a portion of the parking deck at the second level so that approximately 20 spaces will be open to the sky. Since these automobiles cannot be seen from street level this was not considered to be a significant change. Redeveloper is proposing to provide landscaping upon the exposed parking deck.
