



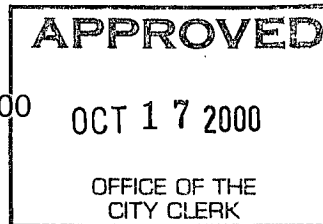

**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPTANCE OF BID AND CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE SILVER EAGLE ROAD/MABEL STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (PN:TU66/TT51)**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Silver Eagle Road between the Natomas East Main Drainage Canal (NEMDC) and Mabel Street and Mabel Street between Silver Eagle Road and Ford Road. Council District 2.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the plans and specifications;
- Accept the bid of Collet Construction in the amount of \$341,010; and
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the Silver Eagle Road/Mabel Street Improvements Project (PN:TU66/TT51).

**SUMMARY:**

The project consists of constructing frontage improvements, including curb, gutter, sidewalk, curb ramps, drainage facilities, and street lighting, on the south side of Silver Eagle Road (Mabel Street to the NEMDC). On the west side of Mabel Street (Silver Eagle Road to Ford Road), we will be constructing similar frontage improvements and reconstructing a portion of the street.

The purpose of the project is to increase pedestrian safety by installing curb, gutter and sidewalk, improve drainage, rehabilitate the roadway, revitalize the neighborhood, and improve the overall aesthetics in the area.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- This project was authorized in the 2000/2001 Capital Improvement Program.
- This project was advertised and bids were received on September 20, 2000 and are summarized below:

Contractor	Bid Amount	ESBE Participation Goal 20%
Collet Construction	\$341,010	27.48%
Biondi Paving	\$343,499	94.47%

- The construction estimate was \$245,000.
- Collet Construction is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and has exceeded the project ESBE goal.
- Award to Collet Construction is recommended.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

- The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction, and construction engineering costs is \$502,984.
- The budget for the Silver Eagle Road/Mabel Street Improvements Project is \$550,000.
- As of October 2, 2000, the total unobligated Measure A Sales Tax Fund 201, Gas Tax Fund 202, and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Fund balance is \$460,638. These funds are sufficient for award.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section Number 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

When an item price is required to be set forth in the Proposal, and the total for the item set forth separately does not agree with a figure which is derived by multiplying the item price times the Engineer's estimate of the quantity of work to be performed for said item, the item price shall prevail

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over the sum set forth as the total for the item unless, in the sole discretion of the City, such a procedure would be inconsistent with the policy of the bidding procedure. The total paid for each such item of work shall be based upon the item price and not the total price. Should the Proposal contain only total price for the item and the item price is omitted, the City shall determine the item price by dividing the total price for the item by the Engineer's estimate of the estimated quantities of work to be performed as items of work.

If the Proposal contains neither the item price nor the total price for the item, then it shall be deemed incomplete and the Proposal shall be disregarded.

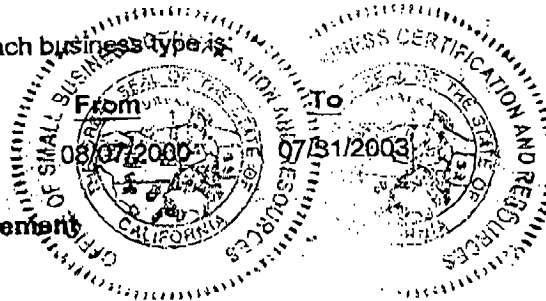
