Approve Plans and Specifications, Budgetary Adjustments, and Award Contract for the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)-10 Pedestrian Crossings Improvement Project (T15216200)

BACKGROUND

- A. The HSIP-10 Pedestrian Crossings Improvement Project (T15216200) will enhance pedestrian crossings across Folsom Boulevard at its intersection with Seville Way; Raley Boulevard at its intersection with Santa Ana Avenue; W Street at its intersection with 8th Street; and Alhambra Boulevard at its intersection with X Street.
- B. The project was identified for funding in Cycle 10 of the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), a federal-aid program with the purpose of reducing traffic fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads. The City applied for and received \$193,600 in HSIP-10 construction funding in 2020.
- C. The project plans and specifications have been completed.
- D. A total of four bids were received on November 19, 2025, as summarized below:

St. Francis Electric	\$ 347,964	17.91%
Pacific Excavation Inc.	\$ 381,528	17.04%
B&M Builders, Inc.	\$ 397,309	71.23%

- E. The project was advertised for construction with an engineer’s estimate of \$384,000 and a local business enterprise goal (LBE) of 5%.
- F. Bear Electrical Solutions, Inc. failed to submit required bid documents, so staff recommends to award to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
- G. Staff recommends that the construction contract be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, St. Francis Electric, Inc.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Plans and Specifications for the HSIP-10 Pedestrian Crossings Improvement Project (T15216200) are approved.

SECTION 2.

The City Manager or designee is authorized to increase the revenue and expenditure budgets of the HSIP-10 Pedestrian Crossings Improvement Project (T15216200) by \$193,600 (Other Capital Grants, Fund 3704).

SECTION 3.

The construction contract for the HSIP-10 Pedestrian Crossings Improvement Project (T15216200) is awarded to St. Francis Electric, Inc. for an amount not-to-exceed \$347,964.

SECTION 4.

The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute the construction contract for the HSIP-10 Pedestrian Crossings Improvement Project (T15216200) with St. Francis Electric, Inc.
