SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

On February 26, 1985, the City Council approved plans and specifications for this project and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on March 19, 1985. Bids received are as follows:

The estimated completion date for the project is November 1, 1985.

FINANCIAL

The City Council has approved \$145,000 in the Public Works Budget from Major Street Construction Funds for this project, of which \$116,000 are available for this project. The estimated construction cost of the project was \$142,000. It is proposed that the required additional funds for this project be transferred from the Meadowview/Amherst Signal Coordination Project, CC: 1823, which has more than sufficient funds to complete that project.
