SUBJECT: Sump 41 Outfall Reconstruction, Located North of Apollo Way and
Piedmont Drive (CC:9677) - Contract Completion

SUMMARY

D.C.M. Construction has completed the above referenced project under
Project Number 9677, Council Contract No. C-85028 dated October 2, 1985.
This work was completed June 6, 1986 at a cost of \$57,367.25 and
acceptance is recommended.

BACKGROUND

On October 1, 1985 the City Council awarded to D.C.M. Construction the
contract for the Sump 41 Outfall Reconstruction project. The general
scope of the project was to replace the outfall pipes on the landward side
and river side of the levee at Sump 41, located north of Apollo Way and
Piedmont Drive.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the project be accepted, the Notice of Completion
and Acceptance of Work be filed with the County Recorder, and the final
payment be authorized.
