

ORDINANCE NO. 1138 FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1060, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 29, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, THE AMOUNT NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated out of the available funds not heretofore appropriated the following sums:

- (a) The sum of \$1640.00 to "SALARIES AND WAGES" - Police Department, Budget No. 18.
- (b) The sum of \$4500.00 to "REPAIRS TO PUBLIC BUILDINGS," Budget No. 49, for the remodeling of the building at No. 615 "H" Street and the third floor of the Hall of Justice.
- (c) The sum of \$470.00 to the COMMUNITY WELFARE COUNCIL.


SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, being an ordinance appropriating money.
