

ORDINANCE NO. 788, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE A PUMP RUNNER FOR USE AT THE SUMP NUMBER TWO WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in the open market for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento a pump runner for use at the Sump Number Two without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.


SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency being that the old pump runner has broken and it will require a minimum of two months to manufacture a new one, and the pump will have to be in condition for use this Fall, that there is not sufficient time to permit the advertising for bids.
