Recommendation of Bid Award for Fire Station No. 15

Frontage Improvements

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On September 1, 1981, the City Council approved plans and specifications for Fire Station No. 15 Frontage Improvements and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on September 22, 1981. Bids received are as follows:

FINANCIAL DATA:

In FY 1977/78 the City Council approved \$270,500.00 in the City Engineer's budget from General Revenue Sharing funds for the construction of Fire Station No. 15 of which \$226,652.16 is currently available. The estimated construction cost for this portion of the project was \$45,756.00.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Engineer recommends that the low bid of C. V. O'Neill in the amount of \$ 38,930.00 be accepted.
