SUBJECT: Resolution To Prohibit Parking On 'X' Street Between Stockton
Boulevard And 45th Street

SUMMARY:

It is recommended that parking on 'X' Street between Stockton Boulevard and 45th Street be eliminated. All residents in the affected area have been notified.

BACKGROUND:

'X' Street is a east/west two lane roadway. Currently, there is on-street parking available on 'X' Street between Stockton Boulevard and 45th Street. Elimination of parking would reduce traffic congestion and improve traffic flow. The University of California Davis Medical Center has proposed building two new parking facilities and intends to use 'X' Street as its major access road to these facilities. Consequently, it is important to UCDMC and the residents of the area to eliminate parking on 'X' Street to minimize the anticipated traffic increase generated by the new parking facilities. This parking removal is being presented to the Council at the request of the UCDMC.

Under the UCDMC Long Range Development Plan, UCDMC intends to (see attachment):

1. Extend 'X' Street east from 45th to 48th Street
2. Extend 2nd Avenue east from Stockton Boulevard to 49th Street
3. Extend 48th Street south from just south of 'V' Street to the proposed 2nd Avenue extension
4. Open two new parking lots of plus/minus 400 cars and plus/minus 600 cars.

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The accessibility to the parking lots would be from the 'X' Street extension and the 2nd Avenue extension respectively. Eventually, UCDMC would be widening 'X' Street to create a landscaped boulevard.

A review of accident history files for the subject area revealed three accidents occurring between January 1, 1985 and February 2, 1987.


FINANCIAL:

There are sufficient funds in the Transportation Division Operating Budget to cover the cost of installing 'No Parking' signs and repainting traffic markings.


RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council approved prohibited parking on 'X' Street between Stockton Boulevard and 45th Street by passage of the attached resolution.



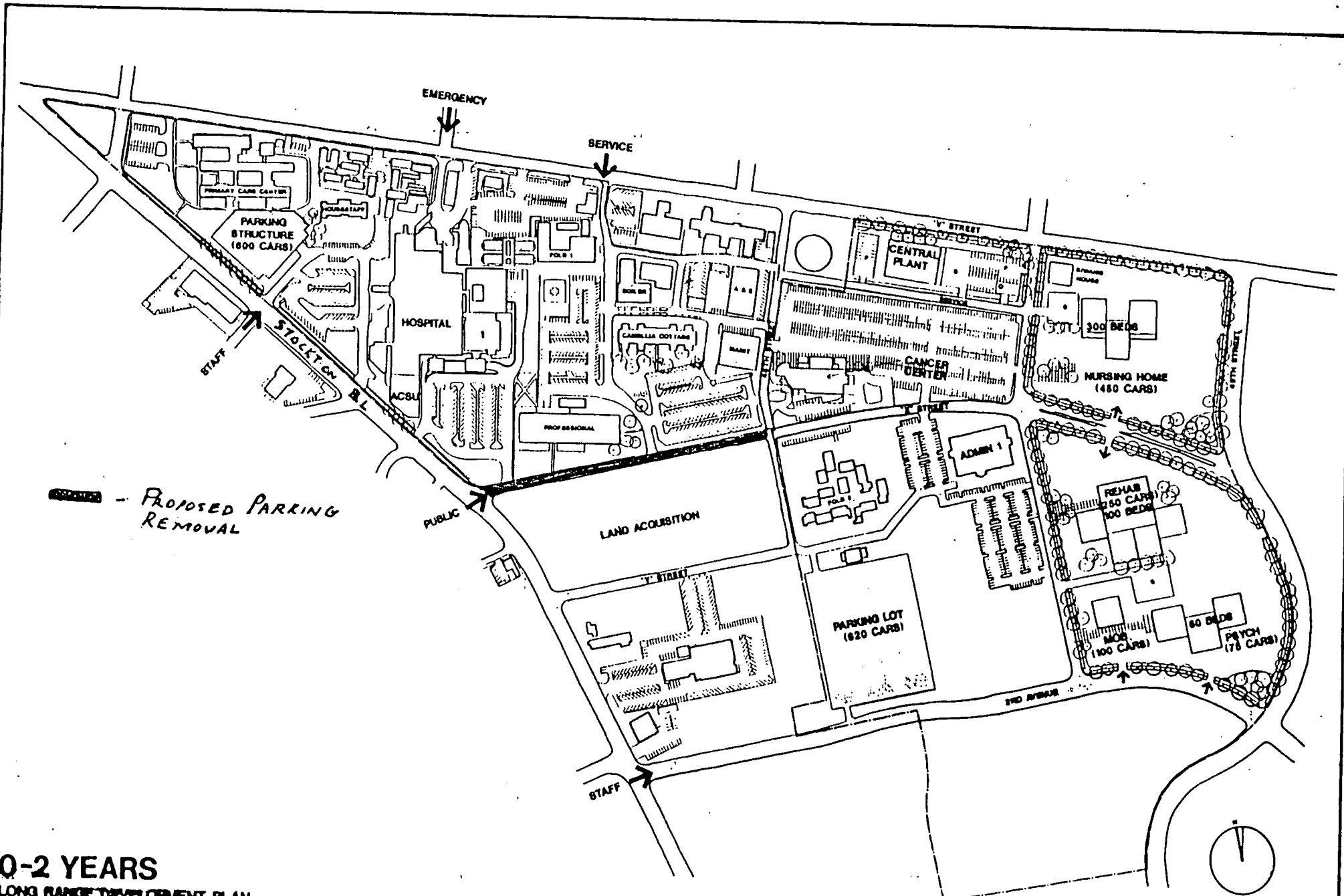
