SUBJECT: Grant Application - Miller Park Shoreline Protection

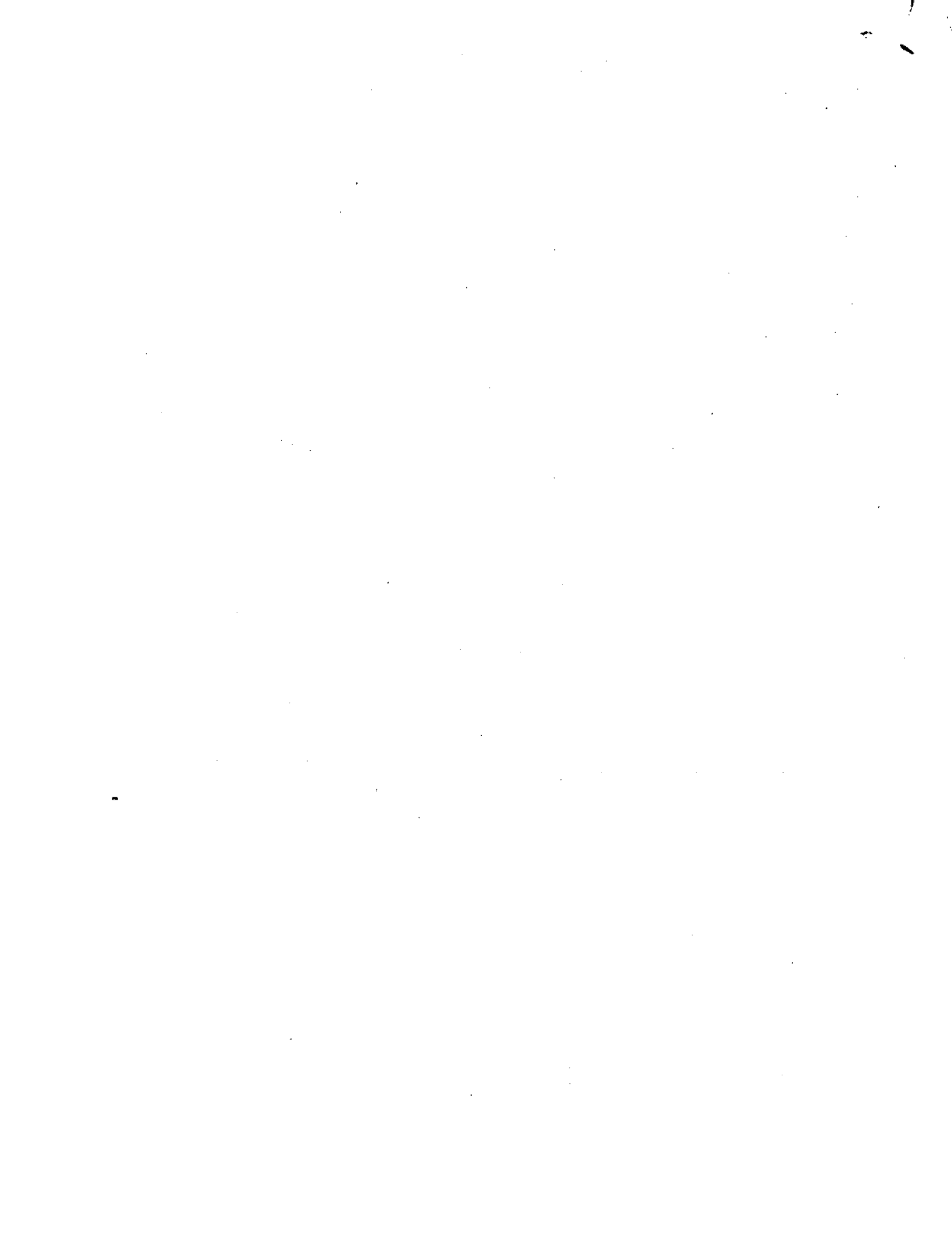
SUMMARY

This report recommends authorization for the Department of Community Services to submit an application to the State of California Environmental Protection Program in the amount of \$950,000 for the purpose of correcting the shoreline erosion and preventing the loss of many large, natural mature trees on the eastern bank of the Sacramento River at Miller Park.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Environmental License Plate Funds are available through the California Environmental Protection Program for projects proposed by any state agency, board or commission, any city or county, the University of California, or any private research organization for projects which will help preserve and/or protect California's environment. The procedure calls for the projects to initially be approved by the State Secretary for Resources, then to the Department of Finance and ultimately to the State Legislature.

In March of 1981, a \$19,800 shoreline erosion survey prepared by CH<sub>2</sub>M Hill was completed. The purpose of the survey was to review probable causes of the erosion and to select and evaluate practical methods of halting the erosion. The Miller Park shoreline erosion problem was attributed to three principal causes: wind and boat generated wave erosion, natural sloughing due to fluctuating water levels, and rainfall and irrigation runoff water cascading down the unprotected slope (the lawn behind the bank is sprinkler irrigated). Recommendations were made to eliminate the erosion problem. To this end, it is proposed that the City utilize Environmental Protection Program funds to place approximately 20,000 cubic yards of granular fill material on a three horizontal to one vertical finished slope outward from the existing bank along about 1,500 feet of Miller Park shoreline.

The total cost for this project is \$950,000. The City staff proposes to apply the entire amount to the shoreline erosion protection project.

RECOMMENDATION


