CONSTRUCTION FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$149,574**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

The 42-Inch Main Relocation on Sandburg Drive Project is located in Council District 3. See attached location map.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution to:

- Transfer funds of \$20,000 from the Base CIP Reserve-Drainage (PN: WE71) to the 42-Inch Main Relocation on Sandburg Drive Project (PN: WK76).
- Accept the responsive low bid from North Star Construction for an amount not to exceed \$149,574 and award the contract.

42-Inch Main Relocation on Sandburg Drive - Transfer Funds and Award Contract (PN: WK76)

The low bidder was North Star Construction with a bid of \$149,574. North Star Construction met the Emerging and Small Business Enterprise (ESBE) goals. It is therefore proposed to award the contract to North Star Construction for \$149,574.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION None.

BACKGROUND

The purpose of the project is to relocate a drainage main onto Sandburg Drive and Minerva Avenue. The existing main crosses three different residential properties and shall be abandoned. There is also an existing maintenance hole in a citizen's driveway that shall be abandoned.

This project was advertised, and seven bids were received on March 20, 2002, as follows:

- The Engineer's construction estimate for this project was \$122,000.
- The estimated completion date is June 20, 2002.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The total project cost including design, construction, inspection and contingency is \$170,000 based on the bid of \$149,574. As of April 2, 2002, the current budget for this project (425-500-WK76-4820) was \$150,000, which is insufficient for award. Therefore, additional funding of \$20,000 will be required to complete this project. It is recommended that funds in the amount of \$20,000 be transferred from the Base CIP Reserve-Drainage (425-500-WE71-4820), in which there is an unobligated balance of \$41,041 as of April 2, 2002.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15302(c) of the CEQA Guidelines. A notice of categorical exemption will be filed with the County Clerk once the project has been approved.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is in conformance with City Code section, 3.60 Articles I & III, which provides that the City Council may award competitively bid contracts to the lowest responsible bidder and "advertising for bidding" requirements respectively.

ESBD CONSIDERATIONS


This project included participation goals of 20% for emerging and small business enterprises as required by Ordinance 99-007 and Resolution 99-055, relating to ESBD participation goals and policies, adopted by the City Council on February 9, 1999. The responsive low bidder, North Star Construction exceeded the ESBE goals with a participation level of 99%.

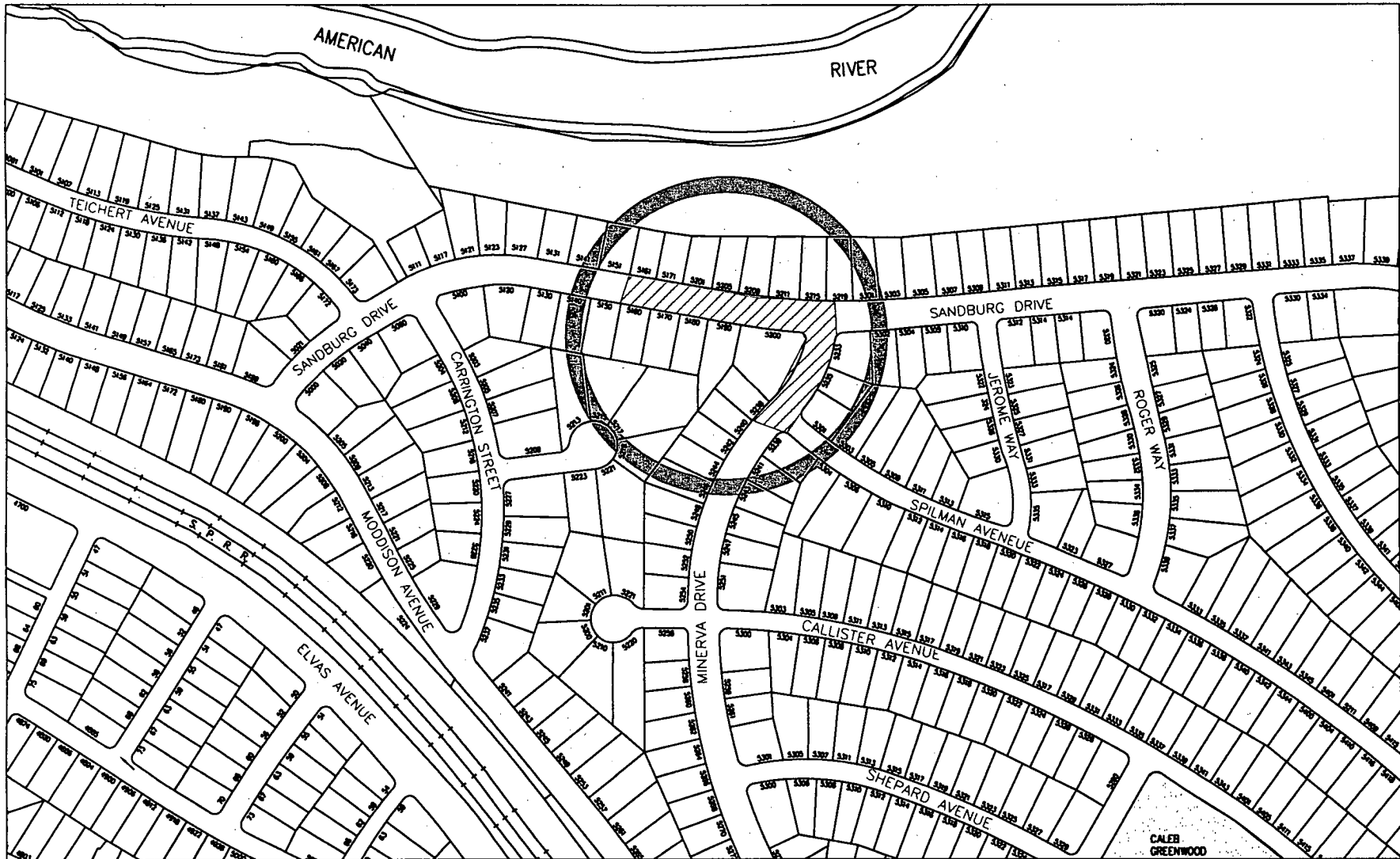

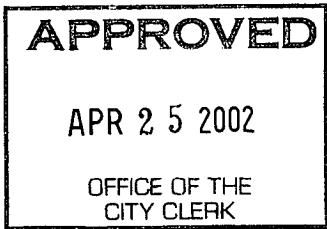
