

SUBJECT: Resolution Approving Negative Declaration for Abandonment of a Portion

of the South One-Half of the Original North C Street Between 16th and 18th Streets and the West 24' of 18th Street Between Thornton Avenue

and the Original North C Street

# SUMMARY:

The Environmental Coordinator has reviewed the subject project and finds that it will not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and therefore recommends that the project and a Negative Declaration be approved by the City Council.



#### BACKGROUND:

In accordance with State EIR Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated December 1976, an Initial Study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the subject project would not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and a draft Negative Declaration was prepared. On June 2, 1983 the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. On June 6, 1983 Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the draft Negative Declaration was published in The Sacramento Union. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for receipt of comments regarding the Negative Declaration, with no comments having been received.

## RECOMMENDATION:

The Environmental Coordinator recommends that the attached resolution be passed which will:

- 1. Determine that the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2. Approve the Negative Declaration.
- 3. Approve the project.



4. Authorize the Environmental Coordinator to file a Notice of Determination with the County Clerk.
