SUBJECT: Capital Gateway Reservoir and Pumping Station (JN:9944) - Resolution  
Approving Negative Declaration

SUMMARY

The Environmental Coordinator finds that this project will not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and, therefore, recommends that the project and a Negative Declaration be approved by the City Council.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the State EIR Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated June 1986, an initial study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the project would not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment, and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared.

On July 31, 1987, the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. On August 1, 1987, a Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the Draft Negative Declaration was published in the Sacramento Union. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for comments regarding the Negative Declaration with no comments having been received.

The construction of the water reservoir and pumping station is consistent with, and identified in, the North Natomas Community Plan. The project is required to meet the anticipated water supply needs that will be generated as North Natomas development occurs.

The Environmental Coordinator recommends that the attached resolution be passed which will:


1. Determine that the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment.



WHEREAS, on July 31, 1987, the Environmental Coordinator of the City of Sacramento filed a Negative Declaration with the County Clerk of Sacramento for the following proposed City initiated project:

CAPITAL GATEWAY RESERVOIR AND PUMPING STATION (JN:9944)

WHEREAS, the prescribed time for receiving appeals has elapsed, and no appeals were received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. That the proposed project, Capital Gateway Reservoir and Pumping Station, located on the west side of the East Drain Canal, approximately 1,500 feet south of Del Paso Road, will not have a significant effect on the environment.

3. That the above-described project is hereby approved for construction of a 3,000,000 gallon water reservoir.
