

ORDINANCE NO. 1960,  
FOURTH SERIES

An Ordinance Closing, Vacating and Abandoning Certain Streets, Avenues, Road, Way, Drive and Court in Oakmont Terrace, in the City of Sacramento.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

**Section 1:** That the following Streets, Avenues, Road, Way, Drive and Court that lie within the exterior boundaries of and that were dedicated on the official plat of Oakmont Terrace, recorded in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County on September 16, 1955 in Book 42 of Maps, Map No. 14:

All of 14th Street;  
All of 15th Street;  
All of 63rd Avenue;  
All of 64th Avenue;  
All of Oakhurst Way;  
All of Laird Court;  
All of Tiverton Road;

All of Southmont Drive lying south of a line parallel to and 76.00 feet southerly, measured at right angles from the centerline of Florin Road, as said centerline is shown on the official plat of said subdivision, are hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.

Said closing and vacating is declared after due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by the City Council, which is hereby made, that said Streets, Avenues, Road, Way, Drive and Court are unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.

**Section 2:** That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within 10 days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
