SUBJECT: PROCUREMENT OF PORTABLE RADIOS

SUMMARY

It is recommended that, in the best interests of the City, the City Council suspend formal competitive bidding for the subject requirement.

BACKGROUND

Fire Suppression needs to replace obsolete portable radios that are not compatible with recently installed radio equipment due to the frequency spread. Motorola Communication and Electronics, Inc. has extended their pricing under the contract (#802060), awarded by the City Council April 12, 1984, for furnishing and installing consoles and required related equipment in the City's new Communication Center.

FINANCIAL DATA

The FY 1984-85 Fire Department Budget (1-01-2530-0000-4630) provides funding in the amount of \$28,394.69 for this requirement.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that, pursuant to Section 57.401(c) of the City Code, the City Council adopt the attached resolution, suspending formal competitive bidding for the acquisition of fifteen (15) Motorola portable radios, Model #H-43SSU3140N, from Motorola Communications and Electronics, Inc.
