

ORDINANCE NO. 95-030

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

ON DATE OF MAY 23 1995

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 7.05.055 AND 7.05.057, AND REPEALING SECTIONS 7.05.058 AND 7.05.059 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE, RELATING TO SALE OF FOOD AND MERCHANDISE FROM THE SIDEWALKS IN OLD SACRAMENTO DURING DESIGNATED SPECIAL EVENTS, AND DECLARING THIS ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Section 7.05.055 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.05.055 Street and Sidewalk Vending - Old Sacramento.

Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, it shall be unlawful for any persons to sell or attempt to sell or distribute any goods, wares, merchandise, food or beverages by means of vending or distributing such goods, wares, merchandise, food or beverages upon any street or sidewalk in Old Sacramento.

SECTION 2.

Section 7.05.057 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.05.057 Vendors With Fixed Business Locations Permitted
to Vend from Sidewalk During Specified Special Events.

Section 7.05.055 notwithstanding, a vendor who has a fixed business location within Old Sacramento from which the vendor regularly sell goods, wares, merchandise, food or beverages may vend these goods, wares, merchandise, food or beverages from the sidewalk or boardwalk

immediately adjacent to the fixed business location during the following special events: Jazz Jubilee, Children's Festival, Railroad Festival, Thursday Night Afterglow, and any other Old Sacramento special event for which the Director of Community and Visitor Services determines that sidewalk vending is appropriate. All tables and vending carts used for this purpose shall be approved in advance by the Director of Community and Visitor Services, or the Director's designee, and shall be positioned so as to leave a minimum of six (6) feet clear on every sidewalk or boardwalk for pedestrians.

SECTION 3.

Sections 7.05.058 and 7.05.059 of the Sacramento City Code are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4.

Chapter 7.05's heading is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 7.05 Old Sacramento - Street and Sidewalk Vending.

SECTION 5.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to take effect immediately. The facts constituting the emergency are the imminence of the 1995 Sacramento Jazz Jubilee which begins on May 26, 1995, and the need to offer Old Sacramento merchants some relief from a decline in sales and revenue which generally occurs during the Jazz Jubilee despite the presence of large crowds in Old Sacramento. Enacting this ordinance as an emergency measure will enable Old Sacramento merchants to share more fully in the economic activity generated by the 1995 Jazz Jubilee. If the effective date of this ordinance is delayed until after the 1995 Jazz Jubilee, then merchants who are limited to vending from within their fixed places of business may suffer economic harm -- instead of benefit -- as a result of the 1995 Jazz Jubilee.
