SUBJECT: ADOPTION OF THE "CITY OF SACRAMENTO MULTI-HAZARD PLAN"

SUMMARY

This report requests that the Transportation and Community Development Committee recommend the adoption of this document as the Multi-Hazard Emergency Plan for the City of Sacramento.

BACKGROUND

The City Council, through adoption of Chapter 72 of the Sacramento City Code, has directed the Director of Emergency Services (City Manager) to prepare a comprehensive emergency plan for the City of Sacramento.

The Multi-Hazard Emergency Plan has been prepared for that purpose and will replace the existing Sacramento City Emergency Plan dated September 1983. This plan complies with the guidelines required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) through the State Office of Emergency Services.


FINANCIAL IMPACT
