SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications and Authorization to Advertise
for Bids for West El Camino Avenue and Truxel Road - Signal and Street
Widening To Azevedo Drive

SUMMARY:

Plans and Specifications for this project have been prepared and copies forwarded to the City Clerk. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

The intersection of West El Camino Avenue and Truxel Road is on the top of the list of City intersections needing signalization. West El Camino Avenue will be widened between Truxel Road and Azevedo Drive. The intersection of West El Camino Avenue and Truxel Road will be enlarged at the same time to match the width of the streets that are being constructed by the City and the subdivision developers in the immediate vicinity.

FINANCIAL:

The City Council has approved \$250,000 in the Public Works Budget from major street construction funds, of which \$230,000 is currently available for the project. The estimated construction cost is \$223,000. A final budgetary recommendation will be made following receipt of bids.
