**SUBJECT:** Approval of Plans and Specifications for Street Light Conversion Program - Phase V

SUMMARY:

The Director of Public Works office has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Copy of said plans and specifications has been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

The subject project represents the fifth year of a ten year program to convert existing fluorescent and mercury vapor street light fixtures to the use of high pressure sodium. The conversion to high pressure sodium permits increased lighting efficiency at a lower cost.

FINANCIAL:

The estimated construction cost is \$23,940.00. The following funds are available for this portion, Phase V, of the Street Light Conversion program:

General Fund	\$ 9,801.68
Gas Tax	55,808.00
Revenue Sharing	5,071.90

RECOMMENDATION:

The Director of Public Works recommends that the plans and specifications be approved and that bids be received on July 3, 1984.
