SUBJECT: Franklin Boulevard at Union House Creek (PN:TC06) - Project Approval
and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

The Franklin Boulevard bridge at Union House Creek needs to be replaced because it is too narrow for the widened street and is hydraulically inadequate for the flow in the creek. This project will replace the bridge, reconstruct the approaches and install a 54" diameter Regional Sanitation District sewer trunkline in accordance with an existing agreement with the County of Sacramento.

The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$673,000.

FINANCIAL

Additional funds may be needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$760,000. The current budget is \$722,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program with \$510,000 from Major Street Construction Funds and \$212,000 from Capital Grant Funds. An additional \$25,000 of Major Street Construction Funds will be available in the 1987-88 Capital Improvement Program. The final budgetary recommendation will be made following receipt of bids.


It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on May 26, 1987.
