SUBJECT: Metropolitan Arts Division - Light Rail  
Station at Benvenuti Plaza

### SUMMARY

This report recommends an increase in appropriations of \$4,000 to the FY 1987-88 budget of the Metropolitan Arts Division for artist's services for art work at Benvenuti Plaza for the Art in Public Places Program.

### BACKGROUND

During the construction of the 16th Street Light Rail Station (adjacent to Benvenuti Plaza), the concrete contractor made an error in the approved color of a concrete block used in partial construction of the Light Rail Station. Staff of the City's Department of Planning and Development allowed the contractor to retain the concrete block, based on the condition that the contractor (Rail Roadway Constructors/Jim Winston and Sons, JV) provide an equal amount of money to that which would be required to remove the existing concrete block. This amount is \$4,000. This money is to be utilized for additional art work to be placed at Benvenuti Plaza (adjacent to the 16th Street Light Rail Station).

On February 25, 1987, the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission approved a proposal by artist Clayton Bailey for art work at Benvenuti Plaza. Currently, Mr. Bailey is under contract with Regional Transit to develop an art work, "Good Fortune", as a part of the Light Rail Art Program at the 16th Street Light Rail Station.

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On April 17, 1987, the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission was notified that Regional Transit had received the \$4,000 from the contractor and was awaiting an invoice from the City to release these funds. Upon receipt of the \$4,000, the City will enter into a contract with Mr. Bailey for an art work at Benvenuti Plaza.

FINANCIAL DATA

An increase in appropriations in the amount of \$4,000 to the FY 1987-88 Art in Public Places Program of the Metropolitan Arts Division is necessary to contract for artist's services for artwork at Benvenuti Plaza. No City funds are requested.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee approve this report and refer it to the full City Council for action. Further, it is recommended that the City Council authorize, by resolution, an increase in appropriations to the Art in Public Places Program in the amount of \$4,000 for artist's services.
