SUBJECT: REPLACEMENT ONE (1) FIRE ENGINE PUMPER TRUCK

SUMMARY

The proposed FY 1988-89 Fleet Management Replacement Budget provides for the replacement of one (1) Fire Engine Pumper Truck for the Fire Department. This report requests authorization for the purchase of one (1) new Fire Engine Pumper truck from Seagrave Fire Apparatus, Inc. under the same terms and conditions as a prior contract, for a total purchase price of \$153,994 (includes sales tax).

BACKGROUND

The FY 1988-89 Fleet Management Replacement Budget has one (1) Fire Engine Pumper truck scheduled to be replaced.

Three (3) new 2000 gallon per minute Fire Engine Pumper trucks were recently delivered from Bid No. 1136 by Seagrave Fire Apparatus, Inc. These units have proven to be quite acceptable. Seagrave Fire Apparatus, Inc. has offered to the City, one (1) unit with 1500 gallon per minute capacity, based on the terms and conditions of the previous contract. Additionally, it could be delivered to the City in approximately 180 days.

By purchasing a fourth unit, identical except for the pump capacity to the three previous units, the Fire Department training is simplified, fewer parts and no new mechanic training is required, and the unit could be put into front line service sooner.


FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost for this requirement is \$153,994 including 6.5% sales tax. \$160,000 has been budgeted in the FY 1988-89 Fleet Management Replacement Budget for this unit.


RECOMMENDATION
