

ORDINANCE NO. 363, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION NUMBER 34 OF ORDINANCE NO. 18, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 22nd, 1921, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSING AND REGULATING THE CARRYING ON OF CERTAIN PROFESSIONS, TRADES, CALLINGS AND OCCUPATIONS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, TO TAKE EFFECT OCTOBER 1st, 1921".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section Number 34 of Ordinance No. 18, Fourth Series, passed September 22nd, 1921, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 34: CLOTHES CLEANING:

For every person, firm or corporation conducting, managing or carrying on a plant, factory, or establishment, for the cleaning or dyeing any garment, fabric, substance, or article, by any process of washing or immersing in a volatile or inflammable oil or liquid, \$6.00 per quarter.

For any person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of sponging and pressing clothing or cleaning and dyeing, but conducting no plant or factory for such dyeing, sponging or pressing, in connection therewith, the sum of \$3.00 per quarter.


PROVIDED, that no city license shall be issued to any person, firm or corporation under this section until said person, firm or corporation has fully complied with the laws of the State of California regulating the above businesses, or any of them, and that no license shall be issued to any person, firm or corporation to do business

under this section except on presentation by the applicant of a valid existing license, where such license is required, from the proper state authorities authorizing such person, firm or corporation to conduct such business under the State law.


PROVIDED FURTHER, that a revocation of any state permit or license by the State Fire Marshall, or other competent state authority, after notice and hearing provided by the state law, shall operate to revoke and cancel any license issued under this section.
