**RESOLUTION NO. 84-375**

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

**RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING AUDREY DIXON BROWN**

**IT IS HEREBY NOTED** that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Audrey Dixon Brown on the twenty-fifth day of April, at the age of 84, in Sacramento, California.

**WHEREAS**, Audrey Dixon Brown was a well-known and respected member of the Sacramento community whose exemplary efforts and accomplishments were of great value to the citizens and the City of Sacramento; and,

**WHEREAS**, Audrey Dixon Brown's outstanding public service career included affiliation with Native Daughters of the Golden West, Chairwoman of the Native Daughters Children's Foundation Committee, California Centennial Committee, the '48 Gold Discovery Committee, the '49er Immigration Committee, 1950 California Centennial Committee, Sacramento Birthday Celebration Committee, the Committee to establish the Camellia Grove in Capitol Park, the Old Sacramento Dedication Committee, the 1976 Bicentennial Commission, Co-Chairwoman of the Committee for the Dedication of the Governor's Mansion, Sacramento Republican Women, and the Salvation Army; and,

**WHEREAS**, in 1957 Mrs. Brown retired as a 20 year employee of the City of Sacramento Health Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Audrey Dixon Brown, and so, has caused this Resolution to be prepared.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Audrey Dixon Brown.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to her bereaved family, as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
