#### BACKGROUND

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency has an opportunity to secure the temporary services of Marvin D. Laskey, Community Development Representative from the HUD P.O. BOX 1834 Office in San Francisco under the Intergovernmental Person-630 I STREET nel Act. This program has as its basis the goal of improv-SACRAMENTO, CA 95814 ing HUD's own delivery system and at the same time, increasing the capacities of local governments to solve their own problems by borrowing personnel with knowledge or skills in a specific process or program.

> This one year program (with possibility of a one year extension) requires the local agency to pay 51% of the employee's annual salary. In this instance, the Housing and Redevelopment Agency would reimburse HUD in the amount of \$15,537 (annual salary is presently \$30,464) plus a share of any federal raise approved in 1980. Fringe benefit costs continue to be borne by HUD.

The Agency will utilize Mr. Laskey's abilities primarily in the McClellan Redevelopment Project, in Community Development Activites as needed and in Housing programs requiring liaison with HUD, where his expertise should be of special value to the Agency.

Mr. Laskey has had many years of experience with HUD and has been the HUD Field Representative to Sacramento for approximately eight (8) years.

#### FINANCIAL DATA

The required payment to HUD of \$15,537 would be provided from each program in which Mr. Laskey performs work. Staff time expended on the McClellan Project will be paid by the County, City and McClellan AFB.

APPROVING CONTRACT WITH HUD FOR TEMPORARY PERSONNEL SERVICES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

- l. The Executive Director is authorized to enter into a one-year contract with HUD for the temporary personnel services of Marvin D. Laskey, under the Intergovernmental Personnel Program. This contract is subject to approval by HUD.
- 2. The contract payment for a one-year period shall not exceed \$15,537 plus 51% of any increase in the HUD salary of Mr. Laskey which becomes effective during 1980.
