Members in Session:

I have canvassed the bids received on December 1st for furnishing the City of Sacramento with 2500 feet of six inch cast iron pipe and find the following to be the two lowest bids submitted:

American Cast Iron Pipe Co.	\$1981.55
National Cast Iron Pipe Co.	1977.36

The bid of the American Cast Iron Pipe Company is \$4.19 higher than that of the National Cast Iron Pipe Company, but in view of the fact that the former company specifies the date of delivery to be December 12th, whereas the National Company could not deliver until February 15th, I recommend that the bid of the American Cast Iron Pipe Company be accepted.
