SUBJECT: Resolution Directing the City Clerk to Advertise for Bids on Florin-Perkins Industrial Park Assessment District, Improvement Proceeding No. 5404

SUMMARY:

Adoption of a Resolution Directing the City Clerk to Advertise for Bids to be received on August 14, 1984 for Florin-Perkins Industrial Park Assessment District. Adoption of the Resolution is recommended.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On July 10, 1984 the Resolution of Intention for the formation of this assessment district was adopted by the City Council setting a hearing for July 31, 1984. The normal procedure is to advertise for bids to be received after said hearing is held. The majority of the property owners within the district desire that we advertise for bids to be received as soon as possible because we are rapidly coming to the end of the 1984 construction season and they hope to get these improvements constructed before the rainy season.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The cost for this project is being entirely financed by the property owners within the district.

The total cost for this project is \$1,165,994.28 based on the following engineer's estimate:

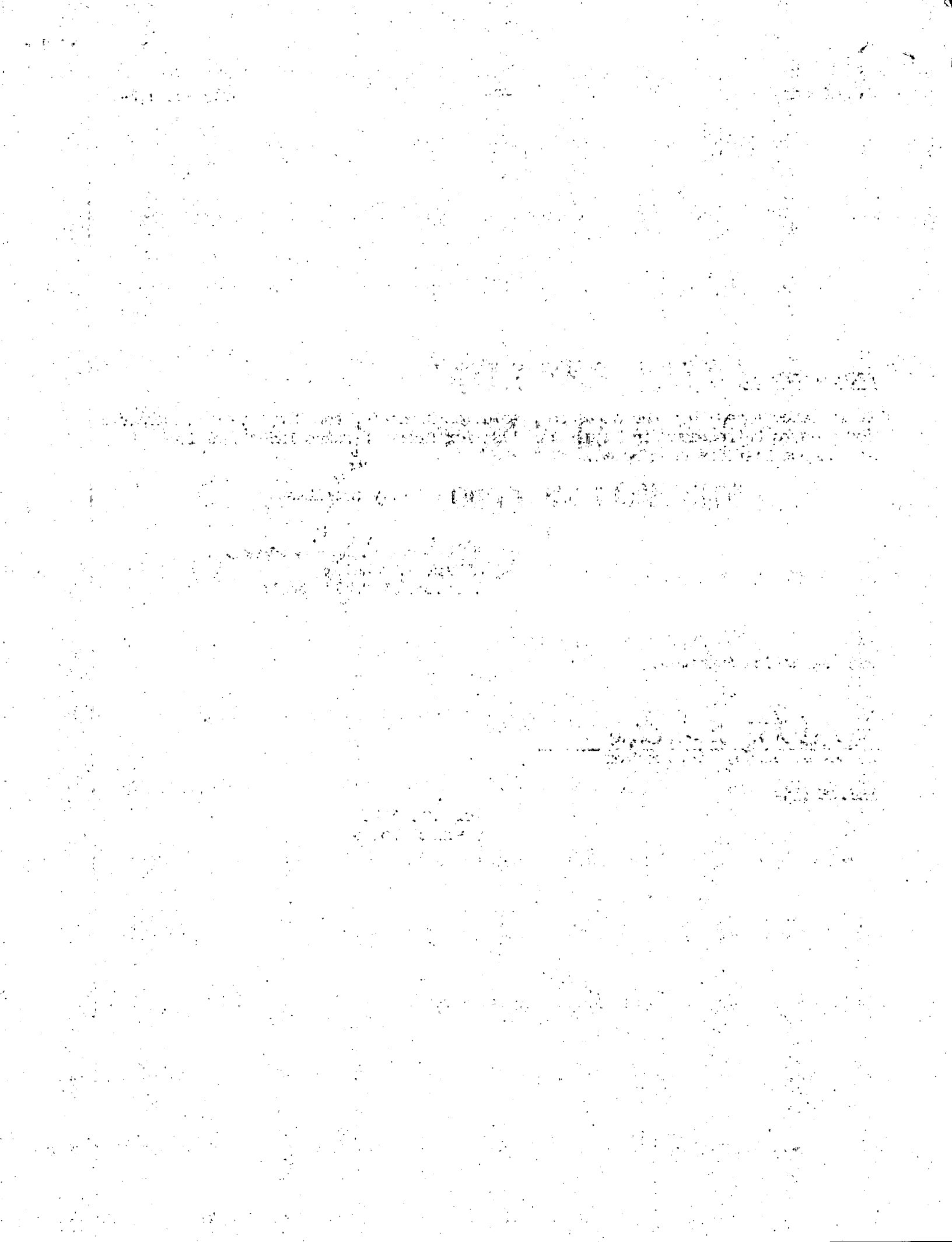
