**SUBJECT: SEWER MAIN REPLACEMENT K AND L STREET ALLEY BETWEEN 8TH AND 9TH STREET (PN:XC76) - PROJECT APPROVAL AND BID ADVERTISEMENT**

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will replace the existing dual combination sewer line in the K and L Street alley between 8th and 9th Streets. The existing sewer lines are damaged and undersized with many depressions. They will be replaced with a single sewer line including all appurtenant structures, maintenance holes, services, and drop inlets.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on May 14, 1990. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$87,200.

FINANCIAL DATA

Additional funds are required for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design, and construction costs, is \$134,900. The current budget for the project is \$50,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program for Sewer Fund (414). The amount currently available for this project is \$24,300 as of June 26, 1991. The final budgetary recommendation will be made following receipt of bids.

A non-refundable fee of \$15.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.301 of the City Code concerning advertisement for bids.


MBE/WBE EFFORTS


RECOMMENDATION

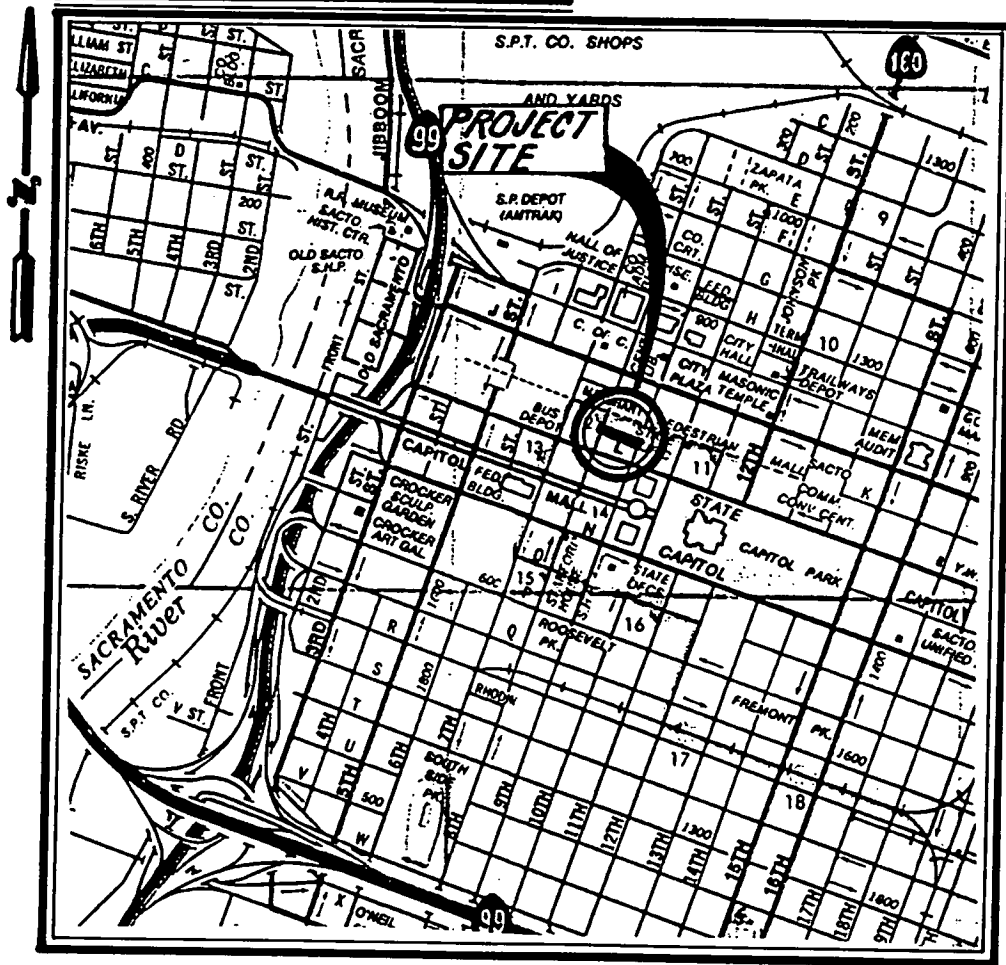
