SUBJECT: RENTAL OF A MALIN YARD WASTE SHREDDER

SUMMARY

The Solid Waste Division of the Department of Public Works is requesting approval to rent a Malin 500 X 2500 diesel yard waste shredder to process leaves and garden refuse this winter, 1990, at a total cost of \$70,000.00.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City of Sacramento has operated a compost program since 1975. For the past thirteen years the program has operated with equipment which was designed to process yard waste in small quantities. In the fall of 1988 and 1989, yard waste was shredded with a rented hammermill-type tub grinder which had a moderate production rate but proved high in maintenance costs and down time, primarily due to the non-organic materials contained in the City's yard waste stream and the gritty, abrasive composition of the material being shredded.

Rental of the Malin screw type shredder will provide staff an opportunity to evaluate the production rates and maintenance requirements of this different type of equipment. It is expected that the production rates will be approximately double that of previous equipment and that maintenance will be minimal. The October 1989 R. W. Beck report on yard waste composting options recommends this type of shredder for a full scale compost program due to it's ability to handle yard waste which has been contaminated with a variety of non-organic materials and the lower maintenance costs associated with it's operation.

This fall the Solid Waste Division plans to accept at least 8,000 wet tons of leaves and yard waste for composting, double the amount processed in 1989. In addition to the yard waste, some wood waste and other types of refuse may be shredded during this rental period to determine the equipment's full range of uses.



The rental rate for the Malin Shredder is \$170.00 per hour for approximately 411 hours of use over a two month period, totalling \$70,000.00 and comparable with the rate for the hammermill-type tub grinder rented in 1989 for \$165.00 an hour. The Malin is the only known available shredder of its type and although used in the East, will afford the City of Sacramento the opportunity to be the first organization on the West coast to use it.

FINANCIAL DATA

Funding for this expenditure is available in the Solid Waste Division's budget line item 415-310-3147-4233 for equipment rental with a remaining balance of \$98,400.00.

POLICY MATTERS

This request deviates from the City's standard formal bidding provision and requires a two-thirds approval of all Council members voting in accordance with the provisions of the City Code Chapter 57.401(c) for non-professional services and supplies.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

No impact.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that, in the best interests of the City, the City Council adopt the attached Resolution Suspending Formal Competitive Bidding for the rental of a Malin Yard Waste Shredder and authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary contract with Iggesund Recycling Systems, P. O. Box M, Rancho Santa Fe, CA 92067 in an amount not to exceed \$70,000.00.
