

ORDINANCE NO. 945, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF UNFIT OR UNNECESSARY PERSONAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 16, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 8 1921, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Any personal property belonging to the City of Sacramento which is unfit, or unnecessary, for the use of the City, shall be sold by the Controller, upon the approval of the City Manager, at public auction, after publication of notice of the time and place of such sale in the official newspaper, for at least five days, and by posting notice thereof at such places, and for such time, as the Controller shall deem best for the information of prospective bidders. The Controller shall have the right to sell any of said property at any place in the City of Sacramento, which shall be deemed by him to be the most advantageous. Said sales shall be made for cash, to the highest bidder, provided that the Controller may in his discretion reserve the right to reject any and all bids.


Provided, however, that during the present national emergency, so declared by the President of the United States, the City Manager is hereby given and granted the authority to deliver any and all of such property to the United States through the Office of Production Management which will arrange for payment at the maximum mill prices established by the Office of Price Administration and Civilian supply, less cost of transportation to the mill or other assembly point designated by it.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 16, Fourth Series, passed September 8 1921, is hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the United States of America is now at war and all scrap metal, especially scrap steel, should be turned over to the Federal Government immediately.
