

ORDINANCE NO. 535, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31ST, 1932, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31ST, 1932, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the fiscal year ending December 31st, 1932, amounts sufficient to meet the expenditure requirements of the City, based on the budget for the fiscal year ending December 31st, 1932, submitted by the City Manager and as determined and adopted by the Council.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance being one appropriating money is hereby made an emergency measure as provided by the Charter.
